

Pupils at Grange are taught the skills of reading through the use of VIPERS, created by Rob Smith (The Literacy Shed).

KS1:

Vocabulary - Draw upon knowledge of vocabulary to understand the text.

Infer - Make inferences from the text.

Predict - Predict what you think will happen based on the information that you have been given.

Explain - Explain your preferences, thoughts and opinions about the text.

Retrieve - Identify and explain the key features of fiction and non-fiction texts such as: characters, events, titles and information.

Sequence - Sequence the key events in the story.

LKS2:

Vocabulary - Find and explain the meaning of words in context.

Infer - Make and justify inferences using evidence from the text.

Predict - Predict what might happen from the details given and implied.

Explain - Explain how content is related and contributes to the meaning as a whole. Explain how meaning is enhanced through choice of language.

Retrieve - Retrieve and record information and identify key details from fiction and non-fiction texts.

Summarise - Summarise the main ideas from more than one paragraph.

UKS2:

Vocabulary - Find and explain the meaning of words in context.

Infer - Make and justify inferences using evidence from the text.

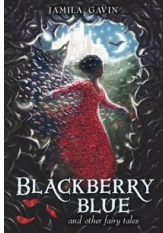
Predict - Predict what might happen from the details given and implied.

Explain - Explain how themes and patterns develop across the text. Explain how information contributes to the overall experience.


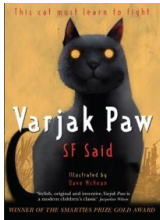
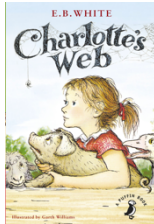
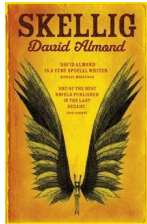
