### **This Half-Term**

We have made it! You are reading this article because we have successfully completed a very productive Autumn 1 2021 half-term!

We have learnt so much and taught so much and our children have made superb progress. I hope you all enjoyed Parent/Carer evenings and found out just how well your children are doing.

Our mission next half-term will be to consolidate the great start to the year. We will work even harder to ensure that our planning of lessons is even more accurate and focussed on the progress of EACH child in the class.

Ms Edwards and Mr Rasheed will be leading that project and we will also review our homework and home learning policy to ensure that it is effective.

Walking around the school yesterday, I was struck by how well the children are listening and how brilliantly the Teachers and Educators are teaching. In every class, the children are either listening with full attention to the teacher (what we call star sitting) or engaged in their work.

The content of the lessons are pitched very well because teachers are thinking so carefully about their planning (which we will get even better at next half-term) and our children of Grange really want to learn.

Our daily routines give our children a sense of safety and structure and it is so pleasing to see how children are getting in and settling down to learn much earlier than before.

Well done to everyone for getting to Grange at 8.30am and for classes settling and getting on with learning so quickly, efficiently and calmly at the start of every day.

### **Building Improvements next half-term**

Thanks to Harrow Local Authority we will get significant, much needed building improvements to our school over the next half-term and term. The aim is for building works to be completed by the Summer Term but the start should have taken place in the last Summer Holiday but the project was not ready to commence.

The works will focus on new roofs over nearly the whole building. This is so necessary because for the past few years we have had to deal with leaky and collapsing roofs!

We will also get wall insulation and new windows which will greatly conserve heat and save on our energy bills.

We will also get new much greener air heating pumps instead of gas which will help us to contribute towards a greener future for our planet.

The works are being paid for completely by Harrow Local Authority using a Grant from Government and we are very grateful for this and hopeful for a greener, more economical future.

The challenge is that we must maintain TOTAL focus on good teaching and learning for our children. We cannot be distracted from that priority. Each child of Grange must make at least GOOD progress! We strive and put every bit of our energy into that!

We will achieve that goal as we have a wonderful Admin Team at Grange led by Mr Hutchinson. They take care of all our needs which will include these building works so that we can focus on high quality teaching and learning so that our children make at least good progress!

I want to thank the teaching staff - Teachers and Educators for their fabulous, powerful and meaningful work this week. It is a pleasure and honour for me to work with such a wonderful and dedicated team and most importantly AN EFFECTIVE TEAM! Our children of Grange are thriving.

I also want to thank the Parents and Carers of Grange because it is just so wonderful to see you all with your support and kindness for your children and the school. This brightens up my morning and afternoon when I see you at Grange.

### **Next Half-Term**

As discussed our focus is on super powerful GOOD teaching and learning, but we also never neglect the social and emotional education and development of our children.

When we return we will have a week of Halloween festivities, honouring of Diwali and the exciting Grange Community Fireworks display!

We will also enjoy our Christmas celebrations and please look out for the return of the real live reindeers to Grange in December.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM



All Grange children wear their school uniform including Reception children as we want our children to feel proud of themselves and their school. Smart and correct uniform plays a big part in giving a child a sense of belonging and identity. ### School uniform consists of:

- Grey or black trousers, skirt or pinafore - can be worn with grey, black or white socks, tights or leggings to the ankle - (leggings are not allowed by themselves).
- Grey or black shorts or skirt with grey, black or white socks, tights or leggings.
- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt (with or without logo).
- Blue check dress with grey, black or white socks, tights or leggings (no other colours or patterns).
- Blue Grange Logo Cardigan or Jumper.
- Black, white or blue headscarf with no embellishments.
- Black leather shoes or completely black trainers (no white soles or logos).

**Please remember to mark all uniform with your child's name**

### Headscarves

We work in partnership with all members of our community and we foster a spirit of mutual respect and understanding for religious and cultural beliefs. We therefore request that when headscarves are worn they are black, white or blue with no embellishments and are of a length that does not present a health and safety risk. Please remember that the children will be participating in physical activities involving a range of apparatus and equipment.

### PE Uniform

PE (Physical Education) is an important part of the National Curriculum, and it requires appropriate clothing. The children should bring their PE kit to school in a separate, named drawstring bag. The necessary clothing and footwear are:

- White T-Shirt
- Dark blue or black sports shorts/track suit bottoms
- Sports trainers/plimsolls for outdoor PE
- Plimsolls for indoor PE
- Dark blue track suit or jumper and leggings for cold weather



Dance and gymnastics are done in bare feet; long hair must be tied back.


**Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly named.**



Year 5 have been extremely busy with experiments this half term.




They explored Forces and Magnets and presented their results on graphs.




Electrifying Science is happening in Y4

Thank you to parents and carers of Year 5 & 6 children who signed up for the Debate Mate Club. The club launch will take place in London on Wednesday 3rd November.





### **Stay Safe Online**



**Squid Games** is trending online and has become an internet phenomenon overnight. As a parent/carer, keep a watchful eye on the content that your children are viewing.

Ensure that the parental controls are activated on your child's device and that age-restricted child profiles are properly set up any on-demand services available through the family TV (such as Netflix, in this case) to prevent inappropriate content being streamed.

If you see your child replicating the challenges from the show or hear them talking about scenes and characters from **Squid Game**, it would be a timely opportunity to discuss with them that the programme is not intended for children, that much of the content would be inappropriate for their age and that the violence in the series is very realistic and often upsetting.
