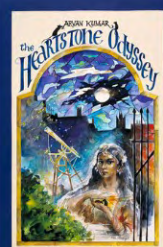

HEARTSTONE ODYSSEY PROJECT



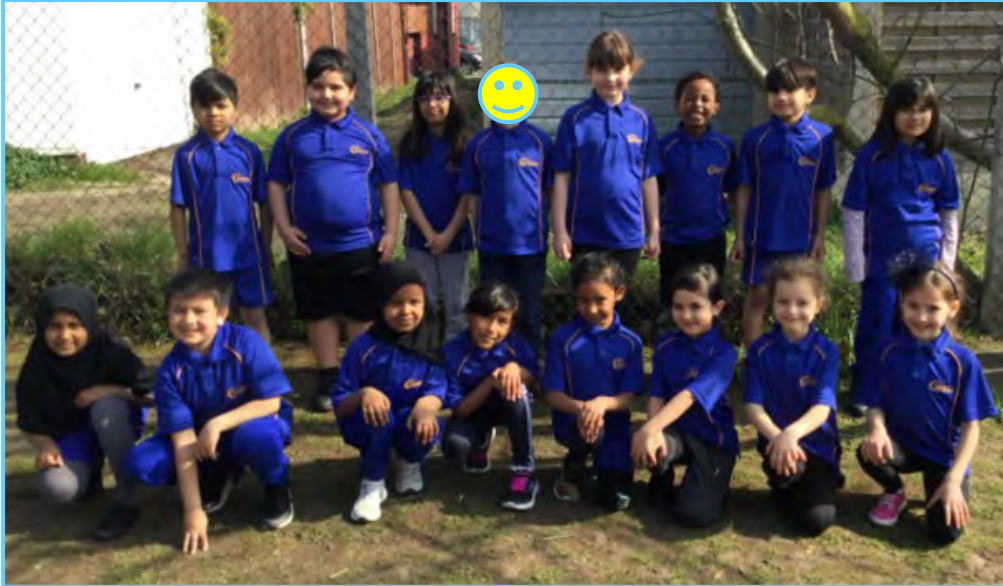
Pupils created various artwork for the exhibition which will be showcased at Greenhill library for general public until the end of April 2022—go down and have a look if you get a chance!

The workshop will provide about the statutory MTC test in June 2022 and how you can support your child at home.

IMPORTANT COVID-19 INFORMATION

- From 24th February self isolation is no longer a legal requirement. However, you are strongly advised to stay at home if you are positive for COVID-19.
