I'm so grateful and happy.

Children, we all are superheroes.

I have a superpower because I can read and write in Braille but you all have superpower too; you can see and run faster than me.

For me, the most important superpower that we all have is in our hearts: Love and Kindness.

Be brave and happy! Thank you. Khloe"

Our student Council were so appreciative and inspired by the visit.

Andrei commented that Superman and Batman are superheroes but they are not real. A real superhero is like Khloe because of the way she uses her senses and changes everyone's life.

"Before I met Khloe I was sad but when I saw her I was happy because I could finally see a superhero."

The student council learnt all about Louis Braille who changed the world because of an idea and invention that he came up with as a child.

They also discussed how Louis' father would have felt when the terrible accident happened to Louis that made him lose his sight but Cosmina said: "If Louis' father was here, I would tell him that because of your son's accident, he would grow up to become somebody who would change the world at the very least for the millions of Braille users!"

We decided that we will face every challenge the CC Way - with Confidence and Consideration and that is why we say: Be Great; Be Grange!

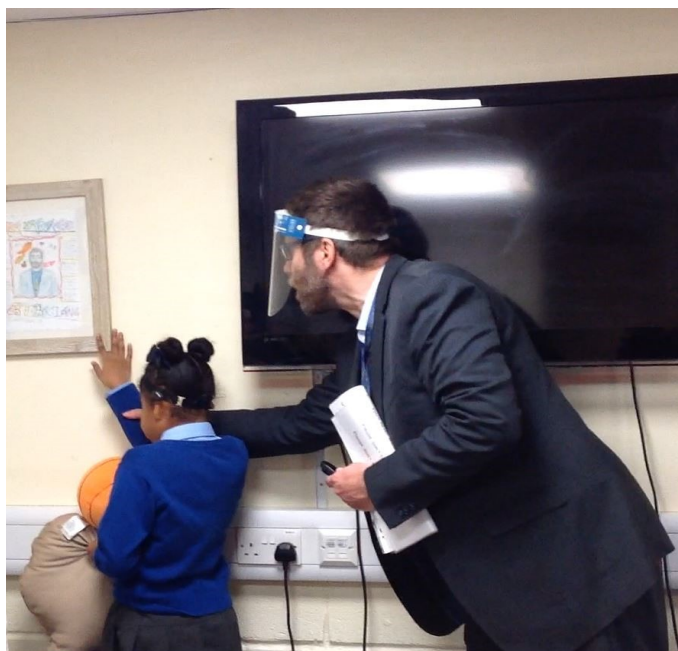
