Dear Grange Community,

We have had a very full week of wonderful learning. Many of our Year 4 children have participated in football tournaments and we have started the Daily Mile at Grange.

We love exercise and Year 3 have been learning about healthy diets in PSHE and science. They were interested to learn about natural sugars and healthy foods. They researched how much sugar is in a fizzy drink and Klee class made a beautiful display about food types and balanced diets. Our children of Grange love their learning.

I enjoyed spending time with pupils from Years 2 to Year 5 to ask them about their learning. They brought their English writing book and their Maths book and a reader at their appropriate level from which they read to me. The books are full of work, clearly dated and it is clear to see the sequence of learning.

In Year 3, a child showed me their purple pen writing in their book and explained that "this is where teacher has told me that I need to do more or to add stuff." It was good to see our marking policy being used well as the child was able to explain to me that green

means "I got it right."

Another Year 3 child told me that to get to a National standard of writing for Year 3, that they need to do "...neater handwriting, lots of prepositions and lots of adverbs – not just 1 but more than 4!"

A Year 4 child explained that her teacher develops her maths language by "...first she explains it out so we understand and then she takes it off the board and we have to figure it out so we really remember it and then it is easier when we do it in the book."

A Year 2 child explained that his teacher helps him to improve his Maths knowledge. He said, "I don't know that much stuff but teacher gives me tips to solve the problems and tells me to count cubes and shows me questions on the board."

One of our Year 5 children was talking about her work and she said "I love Grange. My whole family went here and I made a best friend in Nursery."

What is clear is that our children of Grange are immersed in their learning. Our wonderful, brilliant staff have transformed our school in the last few years and the pandemic has brought us closer as a community. We have realised that we need to work together for the sake of our children in order to build a brighter future for them.

We know that our challenge is to fully liberate the potential of each child through deeply and carefully planned pedagogy whilst nurturing the wellbeing; confidence and consideration of our children of Grange.

We want them to be literate, numerate, confident and considerate and all our staff training is focussed on the Teaching and Learning.

We have amazing children at Grange.

We are truly blessed and thankful to Parents and Carers for entrusting your children to us so that they are 'OUR CHILDREN OF GRANGE'.

Have a great weekend and see you back on Monday for another week of Great Grange Learning and thriving.


