


WORLD BOOK DAY 2022

We had a very exciting World Book Day at Grange on 3rd March, our students participated in paired reading and we were lucky enough to have author Humza Arshad pay us a visit! He read a snippet of his book "Little Badman" to the whole school and we all loved it! He even signed books for some of the children and was nice enough to take pictures with a lot of them!

One lucky student even got his pencil signed!



YEAR 3 MATERIAL DETECTIVES

Year 3 were Material Detectives this week. They explored around the school, identified different materials and discussed the properties.



YEAR 5 SCIENCE INVESTIGATION

In Year 5, the children have been looking at water resistance, following on from their investigation into air resistance. They have been looking at how to increase or decrease the water resistance by considering a number of factors.



Wednesday 23rd February	
Key Vocabulary – Force, Contact, Non-Contact, Friction, Surface Area, Water Resistance, Material, Velocity, Viscosity	
What we want to find out – <i>How the shape of the object affects the water resistance.</i>	
What variables will we change – <i>Surface Area, Shape, Mass</i>	What variables will we keep the same – <i>Material, Height, Temperature, Amount of liquid</i>
The method we will use – (First, next, last) <i>For the first we will use a plastic bottle and we will drop it into the water. Then we will use a ball and we will drop it into the water. Then we will use a paper plane and we will drop it into the water.</i>	We predict that – (I know... so I think...) <i>That the ball will fall first because it has the most mass.</i>
How will we measure the results – <i>We will use a stopwatch to help us measure the results. We will use a ruler to measure.</i>	How will we make our results accurate? – <i>We will drop them from the same height. We will do it 3 times.</i>
Our Results – <i>The first one dropped in 2.15, 2.32 and 2.55 The second one dropped in 1.45, 1.65 and 1.75 The third one dropped in 1.25, 1.45 and 1.55</i>	We learnt – (I know... so I think...) <i>We learnt that flat shape dropped the slowest because it had a larger surface area. The water resistance can push it to shape up. We learnt that the paper plane dropped the fastest because it had a large surface area and a thin surface so gravity could pull it down faster and water resistance struggled to keep it up so that's why that flat shape was the slowest and the paper plane was the fastest.</i>
