So it is at Grange. I write this following our beautiful, well attended Year 6 Graduation Ceremony and Celebration today. These are the imperial Year 6's of Grange. They are our Emperors and Empresses of Grange. They are majestic and their futures are brilliant.

We are so proud of them and their achievements.

The Grange end of Keystage 2 results this year in 2022 are fabulous.

The progress scores in English from the scores in Year 2 to their scores in Year 6 (which is the way progress is measured) is WAY ABOVE NATIONAL.

In Maths the Grange progress score places us in the top 12th percentile for progress in the country!

These progress scores are indicative of the great teaching and the powerful learning taking place in Grange over the year.

Academically Grange has shone this year but there is a symmetrical achievement which is even more important to us at Grange.

Our children have excelled in growing their powers of confidence and consideration.

They have believed in themselves and made good choices and they have been kind and caring.

Although if we look collectively, we see a large mass of children, if we look closer, we see just why Grange is a great school to be part of.

The confidence translates into great writing which was moderated and praised by the local authority. The reading at Grange has ignited and we have children whose working level was evaluated as working below National in Yr 2 but are now reading at greater depth national level.

The consideration is the part that gives us such hope. The children participated in the wonderfully powerful heartstone odyssey which focusses on celebration of difference and true respect and inclusion.

We have our CC way at Grange and we are seeing it bring good results for our children and that gives us hope as we build a better future through the education of our children.

These results are mirrored at the early stages of the school in the Year 1 Phonics results with Grange achieving ABOVE NATIONAL in the Yr 1 Phonics screening.

We are so proud of our children with their inquisitive, curious minds which we aim to nurture, cultivate and assist to flourish!

We need to remember to be grateful and therefore I say thank you to our tremendous Staff of Grange who have worked tirelessly and skilfully with such compassion and care this year.

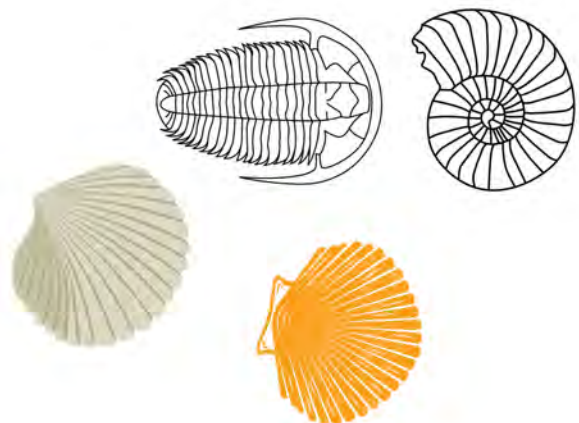

Year 2



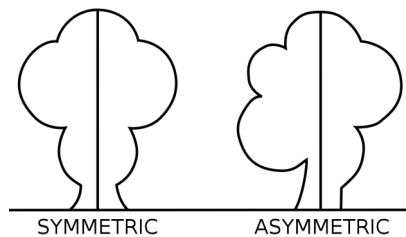
Mass: The amount of matter an object contains.
