Dear Grange Community

Welcome to 2023 at Grange. I'm looking forward to wonderfully good progress for all our children.

All of our Grange adults are working so hard with great skill to meet the needs of the children so that they can thrive.

We have beautiful new book corners in every classroom which have books labelled with ZPD levels.

ZPD stands for 'zone of proximal development'. This was a term coined by the great psychologist and educational philosopher Lev Vygotsky. It means that in order to learn well and make progress, we need to be learning at exactly the right level.

If what we are trying to learn is too hard, we might give up or struggle. If it is too easy, we might get bored and lose interest...but if what we are learning is not too easy and not too hard but just right i.e. the zone of *proximal* development, we will stretch ourselves and really remember what we learn and grow in our knowledge and skills.

This is why it is important to read at the right level for every person and especially a child learning in Primary School.

If the book is too hard, they will not understand and won't really learn anything and might even give up. If the book is too easy, the child will not make progress. That is why the book needs to be at exactly the right level and to get that we have a system called ZPD labelling and every child knows their ZPD score which we get through sophisticated testing and then we have labelled books in our school with a ZPD label and children know how to choose the right ZPD level for themselves. This is monitored by the staff and by the English subject leader at Grange.

If you want to know the ZPD level of a book, you can easily find it by using the website pictured below. You will have fun seeing what the ZPD levels are for your favourite book!

Please make sure to save the dates for the Welcome to the classroom open mornings this term. We love welcoming you safely into school and we are all so excited (staff and children) to share the learning with parents and carers.
