# GRANGE DAY AT BARNET FC SATURDAY 11TH FEBRUARY

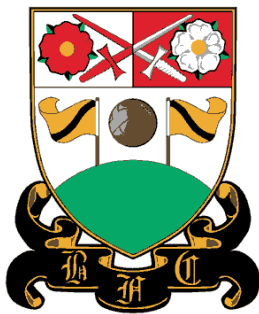
Dear Parents and Carers,

- Strategies to reverse unacceptable behaviour

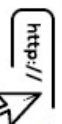
