English: Writing, shared reading, grammar and punctuation, spelling.

Maths: Place value, addition and subtraction, money, multiplication and division, statistics, shape, fractions, measurement, time.

Science: living things and their habitats, plants, materials, animals and scientific skills.

History: Past and present, significant individuals and events, history of transport.

Geography: Maps, comparison of the U.K. and Peru, seven continents and five oceans.

Art & D.T.: Drawing, mechanism, painting, printing and textiles, food technology.

Music: Singing, beat competency and rhythm skills, coordination rhythm patterns.

P.E: Coordination, dynamic and static balance, agility.

PSHE: Respecting rights, healthy living, celebrating difference, relationships, SRE.

Computing: Online safety, grouping and sorting, coding, technology outside school.

Reading


- In-school and at home.

How you could support your child?

- Support them to become independent, organised and ready for school.
- Reward your child at home with class chart points when they complete tasks & for daily reading. The office can support with access should you have difficulty.
