


RE Blog - Spring 1 2023

We have also been thinking about why having this special day is important and healthy and how it affects the family and community.





Year 2 Religious Education

In year 3, we looked at the Qu'ran, the Muslim holy book. We also examined what makes a sacred book unique and why Muslims should respect the Quran.






I felt curious about learning more about Sikhism. I feel curious about what you do in Sikhism.
